



# Membership Policy

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. Casey Radio is a not for profit organisation that provides community broadcast services across the south-eastern suburbs of Melbourne.
- 1.2. Casey Radio encourages applications for membership from the broadcast area and beyond, from people of all ages who enjoy community radio and wish to support the station.

## 2. Purpose

- 2.1. This policy sets out the membership requirements for Casey Radio and it should be read in conjunction with the Rules of Association of South Eastern Radio Association Inc.

## 4. Policy

- 4.1. All members will agree to abide by the Rules, Policies and Procedures of Casey Radio and accept the provisions of the Dispute Policy and Grievance Procedure.
- 4.2. All members will pay their subscription promptly when they are notified that the subscription renewal is due.
- 4.3. Members who are also volunteers will carry out their duties in a competent and professional manner.
- 4.4. All members will be encouraged to attend Casey Radio activities and functions.

## 5. Membership Categories

The membership categories of the Association shall be –

- individual
- family
- concession
- life member
- organisation (not for profit)
- supporter
- corporate

- 5.1. **INDIVIDUAL:** For adults who do not hold a Health Care Card. A member is entitled to a vote at Special General Meetings and Annual General Meetings after 12 months membership and may nominate for the Committee of Management after 12 months continuous membership.
- 5.2. **FAMILY:** Entitles two adults and two children to a family to membership, with one member nominated to exercise a vote at Special General Meetings and Annual General Meetings after 12 months membership. The nominee may nominate the Committee of Management after 12 months membership

- 5.3. **CONCESSION:** The holder of a Commonwealth concession card is entitled to a reduced membership fee. Each financial member is entitled to vote at a Special General Meetings and Annual General Meetings after 12 months membership and may nominate for the Committee of Management after 12 months membership.
- 5.4. **LIFE MEMBERSHIP:** Life members are entitled to a vote at Special General Meetings and Annual General Meetings and may nominate for the Committee of Management.
- 5.5. **ORGANISATION:** (not for profit): An organisation may become a member of the association, and nominate a person to represent and vote on behalf of the organisation. This vote may be exercised after the organisation has been a member for 12 months.
- 5.6. **SUPPORTER:** Supporter members of Casey Radio may be of any member under the age of 15, and or any age, have paid an annual subscription. Supporter members are not entitled to a vote, or to nominate to the Committee of Management.
- 5.7. **CORPORATE:** A business may become a member of the association. Corporate members are not entitled to a vote or to nominate for the Committee of Management.
